

# **Admission Brochure for International Undergraduate Students of Bohai University**

## **( Academic Year 2025-2026 )**

### **I. About BHU**

Bohai University was founded in February 1950. As a comprehensive university administered by the Liaoning Provincial Government, it is located in Jinzhou City, Liaoning Province—a heroic city and picturesque region on the shores of the Bohai Sea. The university is an institution authorized to train international students under the Chinese Government Scholarship Program and the International Chinese Language Teacher Scholarship Program.

The university covers an area of more than 1.5 million square meters, with a total construction area of 600,000 square meters. There are 20 colleges in BHU, offering 53 programs for Bachelor's Degrees, as well as 17 programs for First-level programs for Master's Degrees and 18 programs for Professional Master's Degrees, including economics, laws, education, humanities, history, philosophy, science, engineering, agriculture, management, arts, etc.

The university boasts well-developed infrastructure, with a library collection exceeding 3 million volumes and equipment that fully meets teaching and research needs. The campus environment is picturesque, lush with greenery. It was honored as “Liaoning's Most Beautiful Campus” in 2019 and awarded the title of “Liaoning Provincial Civilized Campus” for the 2021-2023 period. The university is recognized as a National Model Unit for

Greening, a Liaoning Provincial Model Unit for Greening, a Liaoning Provincial Demonstration School for Campus Greening, a Liaoning Provincial Safe and Civilized Campus, and a Liaoning Provincial Demonstration Base for Ecological Culture Education.

The university has established cooperative relationships with institutions in over 30 countries and regions, implementing joint graduate programs with dual Chinese and international supervisors. It collaborates with the University of Life Sciences in Warsaw, Poland, on a Sino-foreign cooperative education program. The Confucius Institute at the University of Burundi was recognized as an “Outstanding Corresponding Confucius Institute” among the “Global Model Confucius Institutes.” A faculty member from the Confucius Institute at the University of Bangui was honored with the Academic Palm Medal by the President of the Central African Republic. The university has educated over 1,000 international students from nearly 80 countries, contributing significantly to enhancing the “Study in China” brand in Liaoning Province.

## **II. Admission of Self-Funded Undergraduate Degree Students**

### **A. Undergraduate Programs Taught in English**

BHU offers four undergraduate English-taught programs for international students, including Business Administration, Software Engineering, Tourism Management, and Electrical Engineering and Automation, with a four-year duration and a tuition fee of RMB 13,000 per year.

**Business Administration** mainly cultivates middle and senior

management talents who master the professional knowledge and fundamentals of modern management theory, possess strong management decision-making, communication and execution abilities, and skillfully apply management knowledge and methods to manage enterprise-related work.

**Software Engineering** aims to cultivate high-quality, application-oriented technical talents who are at the forefront of the discipline of software engineering and have employment competitiveness in software engineering technology research, design, development, management, service and other related fields.

**Tourism Management** focuses on creating high-level and new professional positions such as international hotel management trainees, managers of budget chain hotels, overseas tour leaders, customized travel butlers, tourism big data analysts, etc. Some graduates of this major have been successfully employed in high-level hotels in Hainan, China.

**Electrical Engineering and Automation** mainly cultivates professional and technical talents in the field of electrical engineering and automation with innovative thinking, fine skills, engineering knowledge, solid mathematical basic knowledge, international vision and innovation and entrepreneurship ability. This major has been favored by international students.

**Note: When submitting application materials for the above English-taught undergraduate programs, applicants must also provide their CSCA Mathematics subject test score report. For Software Engineering and Electrical Engineering and Automation majors, applicants must additionally submit scores from either Physics or**

### **B. Undergraduate Programs Taught in Chinese**

All undergraduate programs currently offered at Bohai University accept transfer international students enrolled in Chinese-taught courses. Applicants must demonstrate Chinese proficiency equivalent to HSK Level 3 with a score of 180 or higher. The following programs are highly recommended.

### **C. Application Materials for Studying in China**

- (1) Passport photo page (scanned copy). If the applicant has previously visited China, all pages with entry/exit stamps, all visa pages, and all pages with residence permits must also be provided;
- (2) Notarized high school diploma or equivalent qualification certificate. If

the document is in a language other than Chinese or English, a notarized Chinese translation must also be provided (scanned copy);

(3) High school or equivalent academic transcript. If in a language other than Chinese or English, a notarized Chinese translation must be provided (scanned copy);

(4) Bohai University International Student Application Form (Word document), downloadable from the official website of Bohai University International Education College (<http://www.bhuwsc.com/>);

(5) ID Photo with white background (electronic version);

(6) CSCA (China Scholastic Competency Assessment) score report (must be submitted concurrently with other materials).

### **III. Scholarship Programs for Undergraduate International Students**

Bohai University is an institution authorized to train international students under the Chinese Government Scholarship Program and the International Chinese Language Teacher Scholarship Program.

**A. The China Government Scholarship (CSC Scholarship)** is a fully or partially funded program established by the China Scholarship Council (CSC). It aims to support outstanding international students and scholars in pursuing studies or research at Chinese universities, thereby promoting international educational exchange and cooperation. For specific application procedures, processes, and required materials, please refer to the Study in China website ([www.campuschina.org](http://www.campuschina.org)). Submit application materials according to the requirements of the CSC's "Online Application System for Studying in China," and simultaneously submit the CSCA (China Scholastic

Competency Assessment) score report.

**B. The International Chinese Language Teacher Scholarship,** established by the Center for Language Education and Cooperation under the Ministry of Education, focuses on cultivating qualified overseas Chinese language teachers. Applications for this scholarship program typically open on March 1st each year via the Center for Language Education and Cooperation website (<http://www.chinese.cn>). Undergraduate applicants must major in International Chinese Education. For specific application procedures, processes, and required materials, please refer to the “International Chinese Teacher Scholarship Admission Prospectus” published by our university for the relevant academic year. Applicants must submit a transcript of China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA). The deadline for submitting the transcript is May 15, 2026.

#### **IV. Regarding China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA)**

China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA) is an academic proficiency assessment administered by the China Scholarship Council for international students applying to undergraduate programs in China. All applicants seeking undergraduate degrees at our university must take this test and submit their CSCA score report during the application materials submission phase.

The test covers four subjects: Professional Chinese, Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry. Chinese and English versions of the Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry papers are available. Applicants may select the language of their test papers based on their preferred language of instruction.

## **A. Professional Chinese**

Applicants seeking undergraduate programs taught in Chinese at our university must take the Professional Chinese test. This test is divided into two categories: Liberal Arts Chinese and Science Chinese. Applicants should take the corresponding test based on their chosen academic discipline.

Applicants for undergraduate programs taught in English are exempt from this test. Applicants for undergraduate Chinese Language programs may be exempted if they provide a valid HSK Level 4 score report.

## **B. Mathematics**

Applicants seeking admission to undergraduate programs at our university must take Mathematics as a required subject, regardless of program category or language of instruction.

## **C. Physics and Chemistry**

Applicants applying to undergraduate programs in Science, Engineering, or Agriculture must select one of these two subjects for examination.

Starting in 2026, testing services will be offered five times annually in January, March, April, June, and December. Specific test dates and arrangements will be published on the official website ([www.csca.cn](http://www.csca.cn)).
